### <What is Hakuba Jazz®?>

- Application:** Applicants will be screened by the Hakuba Jazz® secretariat. Please apply by submitting a video link of your performance. Detailed application instructions are provided below.
- Stage:** Performances will be held at various locations such as “Usagidaira,” which offers views of the distant Yatsugatake and Mt. Asama, located at an altitude of 1400m on Hakuba Happo-one. \*The performance location may change depending on weather conditions.
- Genre:** There are no genre restrictions, but we request performances that suit the atmosphere of Hakuba Jazz® and Hakuba Happo-one.
- Opportunity:** Hakuba attracts many tourists from all over the world during the Green Season. This is your chance to perform in this international atmosphere. (There may also be opportunities to perform at local restaurants and other venues in the evenings. This can be discussed.)
- Sound Equipment:** We will provide YAMAHA STAGEPAS600. Please connect your instruments and perform. Note that there will be only one power line (1500W).

- Lunch:** Provided at Happo-one, round-trip gondola tickets, and free parking (Note: Transporting equipment is the responsibility of the artist).
